

Orienteering NSW and the NSW Active Kids Program



Active Kids is an NSW government program that provides a \$100 voucher to parents/guardians of school-enrolled children. The \$100 voucher can be used for registration and participation costs for sport and fitness activities.

In support of Active Kids, ONSW is pleased to offer the following options for orienteering in 2019:

- (1) Junior membership to the value of \$40, plus 8 local events (including the hire of a Sportident stick if required), or
- (2) Entry to 8 NSW State League events* (this excludes 2019 State League events organised by OACT), or
- (3) Entry to 10 Saturday Orienteering Series events in 2019 (including the hire of a Sportident stick if required)

To redeem your voucher, please email **John Murray** (<u>admin@onsw.asn.au</u>) in the ONSW office with the child's name, DOB, voucher number and your choice of one of the above options.

For those families who have not yet renewed their membership for 2019, and who select the membership option (#1 above):

* if there is one child in the family, the cost of family membership will be discounted by \$40

* if there are two or more children in the family, the cost of family membership will be discounted by \$80.

Once the ONSW office receives the voucher(s), the 2019 membership can then be processed.

There will be another voucher issued in 2019 for Summer sport and you can then redeem for 2020 membership options.

With each of the options above, they are not transferrable and cannot be mixed.

* For 2019, if you wish to use an Active Kids voucher for entry into a State League event, after you've claimed the voucher from <u>ServiceNSW</u>, you will need to advise **John Murray** of:

(a) the voucher number,

(b) which State League events you wish to enter your child/children in and their age class.

This is so the office can make the entry on your behalf and register the 'payment' at the same time.

To be eligible each child (4.5 \sim 18) must be enrolled in school from K to Year 12.
