## **Event Five: Sunday 7 August**

Event 5 in the 2011 Junior League series is on a new map -Cattai National Park - especially prepared for this combined Junior League #5 / MetrO League Final event! The National Park is off Wisemans Ferry Road, north of Windsor and just north of Cattai. It is adjacent to the Hawkesbury River and is a mix of bush and semi-open land that was previously farmed.

**Parking:** The designated parking area for orienteers is in a field within the National Park. After turning off Wisemans Ferry Road, follow the O signs along a dirt and rough bitumen road approximately 1.4km to the parking area. Please note, the first part of this road is private property and we cannot park on this. The road within the Park also must be kept accessible to other Park users and local landowners, so Orienteer parking must be in the designated field. A WHO parking person will be on hand to help direct people. The Start for all courses is 200m from the parking area, along a track, and the Finish is in the same field as the parking.

Special Instructions: Please note, there are some special requirements to use this National Park and it is essential that we prevent the spread of Myrtle Rust. All competitors and spectators must please clean shoes and clothes BEFORE coming to this event (and afterwards). If your car has been in a known Myrtle Rust area, eg Central Coast, it should be cleaned also.

In addition, just before the Start there will be small tubs with cleaning fluid in them for all orienteers to use on the soles of their shoes, to prevent the spread of Myrtle Rust (a native plant disease that is not yet present in Cattai National Park).

Please allow extra time if you need to purchase a day pass and to use the shoe cleaning tub on the way to the Start.

## Additional charges for this event:

- 1. National Park day use fee is \$7 per car, unless you have an Annual Pass. A day use pass can be purchased at the ticketing machine 300m down the main road into the Park, using coins (10c to \$2) or credit card. The turnoff to the ticketing machine is approximately 1.3km from Wisemans Ferry Road ie 100m before the Orienteering parking field.
- 2. There is an additional charge by National Parks of \$2.20 per entrant (including GST), which will be collected at the briefing.
- 3. SportIdent will be used, if you do not own an SI stick, one can be hired at the event for \$2. (Sticks can also be purchased from Series sponsor, AussieOGear www.aussieogear.com).

Facilities: There will be one Portaloo at the Assembly area. The Park's public facilities are also available but are a 2.4km drive away in the Park's southern picnic area.

Out of Bounds: Until you have finished your course, the Park (apart from the parking and assembly areas as well as the southern picnic grounds) is out-of-bounds.
