

Orienteering NSW and the NSW Active Kids Program



Active Kids is an NSW government program that provides a \$100 voucher to parents/guardians of school-enrolled children. The \$100 voucher can be used for registration and participation costs for sport and fitness activities.

The Active Kids voucher holder will need to be a financial member of Orienteering NSW to redeem either of the 1st 3 options below.

In support of Active Kids, ONSW is pleased to offer the following options for orienteering in 2021:

- Entry to 10 Saturday Orienteering Series events in 2021 (including the hire of a Sportident stick if required);
- (2) Entry to 15 Local orienteering events (not SOS or State League events) in 2021 (including the hire of a Sportident stick if required);
- (3) Entry to NSW State League events up to the value of \$100. For this option, please enter State League events as normal in Eventor. Once you have reached or exceeded the \$100 value, apply to the ONSW office for the Active Kids reimbursement: and
- (4) Junior membership plus \$60 value at SOS, Local or State League events by application to the ONSW office.

To redeem your voucher, please email **John Murray** (admin@onsw.asn.au) in the ONSW office with the child's full name, DOB, voucher number and your choice of one of the above options.

With each of these options, they are not transferrable and cannot be mixed. Events chosen must be all Local, all SOS or all State League to be accepted.

To be eligible each child (4.5 - 18) must be enrolled in school from K to Year 12.
