



# 2018 NSW SCHOOLS ORIENTEERING CHAMPIONSHIPS INVITATION



## September 1-2, Hills District

The 2018 NSW Schools Orienteering Championships are a **two-day event**. You may enter **Sat or Sun or both days**.

### Description of the events

**Saturday:** consists of 2 'sprint' races. Courses are short (1.5-3km depending on the age class) and held mainly in urban environments with clear boundaries (uni campuses, former hospital sites, sporting complexes etc). The winning time in each age class will be approximately 15-20 minutes. Both times are added to calculate the winners.

**Venues:** **The Hills Grammar School, Kenthurst (10am)** and **Cherrybrook Technology High School (1.30pm)**.

**Sunday:** one 'middle distance' race. Held in a bush environment and designed to test cross-country navigation. Courses are of medium length (1.5-6km depending on the age class). The winning time in each age class will be approximately 40 minutes. All participants must carry a whistle – if you do not have one, we will supply one.

**Venue:** **Wianamatta Regional Park, Ropes Crossing (9am)**.

### Explanation of age classes for bush events on Sunday:

M10A	W10A	'Very easy' courses: about 1.5 km, navigable without a compass, and following 'handrails', which are linear features such as tracks, fences, well-defined watercourses and vegetation boundaries. Sample <a href="#">map</a> .

M12A	W12A	'Easy' courses: 2-2.5 km, they encourage simple distance estimation and basic corner cutting without a compass. Control sites should be on large visible features within 10m of the handrail. Sample <a href="#">map</a> .

M14A	W14A	'Moderate' courses: 3-4km, requiring a compass to take cross-country routes. There may be a choice of tracks on some legs. Control sites are near obvious 'catching features' or 'attack points'. Sample <a href="#">map</a> .

M17+A	W17+A	'Hard' courses: 3-6km, requiring fine compass work. They test all types of orienteering skills: map reading and navigational skill, the ability to assess route choice. For experienced bush orienteers only. Features are often small (boulders etc). Sample <a href="#">map</a> .
